- All vendors will receive a 12x12 space, you may bring a table, canopy, and of course, lots of fun decorations. Be kind to each other and keep all decorations within your space. Be mindful of the trick or treaters who have mobility difficulties when planning your theme, and please, no flashing lights. It can be windy at the field, canopy legs may need to be weighed down (stakes not allowed due to specialized field surface). Electricity is very limited, and will be on a first come, first serve basis.
- This event is for the Miracle League players and their siblings. To keep the line moving, please, no raffles or signups for families. We plan to recognize all of our incredible vendors and their generosity in each trick or treater's goody bag.
- We should have an approximate head count at the beginning of October. In past years, we've had 150-200 trick-or-treaters. We have a few athletes with allergies, you may want to have a non-food alternate treat.
- For safety's sake, only service animals will be allowed. Please let us know if one will be attending.
- You may come as early as 4pm and no later than 5pm for set up. We would like everyone set up, costumed and photo ready no later than 5:45pm. Our kiddos get very excited and want to start right at 6pm.
- Our event runs until 8pm, please wait until after the last trick or treater has finished before breaking down your space.
- Please be mindful that our field is specially designed for our athletes, treat with care and take all decorations with you. We will have trash bags and a dumpster available if needed.
- After the last trick or treater has come through, we will be judging and awarding those with the "Most Original", "Best Costumes", "Best Decorated Booth", "Player Favorite", "MLNC 'Booo'ster Award"
